



Sweden X-35 Grand Prix Series

Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012.
- 1.2 X 35 class rules will apply.
- 1.3 All boats shall in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 display advertising provided by the event organiser.
- 1.4 ISAF Sailor Classification, Regulation 22 will apply.
- 1.5 Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race.

2 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall fill in and return the self declaration "Checklist X-35 Class Rules" that will be sent to each boat before GP 1.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3 ENTRIES

- 3.1 Advance entry shall be made by e-mail to lars.sorqvist@sandholm.se not later than 26 April 2010.
- 3.2 The advance entry shall include the following: name of the boat, sail number, skippers name, skippers address, telephone number, e-mail and yacht club.
- 3.3 The entry fee for the entire GP-series is SEK 4000 and is to be paid to the Swedish X-35 Association (John Müllersdorf: SEB 52063000875) not later than 30 April 2010.

4 REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

- 4.1 Registration shall be made at the local race office at each GP not later than 08.30 the first day of the regatta. Measurement checks may be performed.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be sent out to the participants before the first GP.

6 TIME SCHEDULE

- GP 1** Hägernäs 8-9th May (Viggbyholm Boat Club)
4-6 Course races at Hägernäs 9 May
The coastal race consists of Round Lidingö Race 8 May
- GP 2** Nacka Strand Sail Arena 13-14 May (Nacka Strand Yacht Club)
4-6 Course races and 1 coastal race

GP 3 Saltsjöbaden 21-22 August (Stockholm Yacht Club)
4-6 Course races at Baggensfjärden
The coastal race consists of Kräftköret

GP 4 Nynäshamn 18-19 September (Nynäshamns Yacht Club)
4-6 Course races and 1 coastal race

At each GP, regatta dinner and social activities are organized on land. The crews of the racing yachts are asked to take part in the regatta dinner at Saturday evening at each GP.

7 RACING AREA

7.1 The racing area will be close to the yacht clubs at each racing arena.

8 THE COURSE

8.1 At each GP 4-6 course race on a windward-leeward course and 1 coastal race (around 3 hours) will be sailed.

9 SCORING

9.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply for each GP and for the total GP series where the results of the four individual GP are used for calculating the total result of the series.

10 PRIZES

10.1 Prizes are given to the winners of each GP. Special prizes will also be given for the winners of each coastal race. The winner of the total Grand Prix Series is given the Swedish X-35 Grand Prix Trophy.
